

## The Chapel 2017



ANNOE PLACE CHAPEL, c. 2005. The chapel building, which may date to before 1812, is associated with its famous pastor, the Rev. Paul Cuffee (1757–1817), a Shinnecock Indian, who preached to the local Native American tribes “with fidelity and success.” Though, in 1943, the building received electric lights, it has not been heavily modernized, and has now been preserved by the Town of Southampton (HPS).
