



ANOE PLACE CHAPEL, C. 2005. The chapel building, which may date to before 1812, is mo sociated with its famous pastor, the Rev. Paul Cuffee (1757–1817), a Shinnecock Indian, where eached to the local Native American tribes "with fidelity and success." Though, in 1943, the tilding received electric lights, it has not been heavily modernized, and has now been preserved to Theory (LIDE).
